SCENIC ROAD CRITERIA

Roads that Alachua County designates as Scenic must meet the following criteria:

• Scenic significance:

- o Interesting geomorphic formations
- o Type of natural vegetation
- Presence or nearness of bodies of water
- o Overall landscape composure

Historical significance

- o Road developed prior to era of interstate development
- Sites of historical importance

Cultural significance

- Unspoiled character of resource (no adverse land use and structures)
- Amenability for multiple recreational uses for pedestrian, equestrian or bicycle paths and passive recreation

• Preliminary priority of criteria

- Scenic quality
- Variety of recreation experience
- o Compatibility with other road users
- o Harmony with other land use
- o Access to parks and other recreation
- Popular demand
- o Degree of urgency if the road is to be protected
- Protection of ecology
- Suitability for use by other transportation modes (ie. Buses, pedestrian, equestrian and bicycles)
- o Type of developmental possibilities
- o Resource vulnerability to non-compatible land use
