Transportation Mobility Element

- Removes references Transportation Concurrency in Urban and Rural Areas to comply with tenants of State Statute for Alachua County's Alternative Mobility Funding System.
- Removes Transportation Concurrency Exception Area and Transportation Concurrency Exception for Projects that Promote Public Transportation.

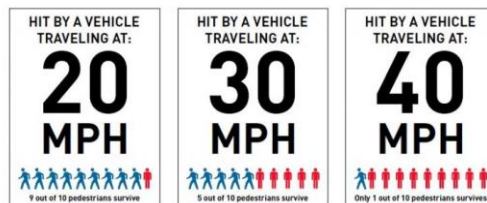
Transportation Mobility Element

- Revisions to Level of Service (LOS) to update LOS of Strategic Intermodal System in Urban Area and roadways within Rural Area.
- Revisions to some specific references to “dedicated transit lanes” to refer to rapid transit service in case dedicated lanes are not feasible in all instances and locations.



Transportation Mobility Element

- New policy for some electric vehicle charging to be required in Multifamily developments.
- New safety objective and policies aimed at reducing crashes and transportation related fatalities.



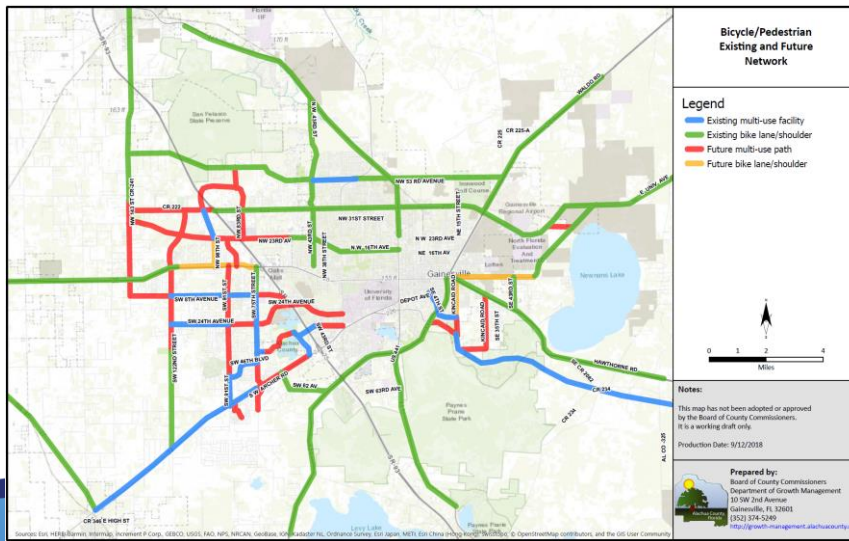
Speed is especially lethal for vulnerable users like pedestrians and people biking. The risk of injury and death increases as speed increases.

- Updated Transportation Project Tables in Capital Improvements Element and TME Maps to remove completed projects and projects specifically directed by the Board

Capital Improvements Element

- Removed explicit language regarding Transportation Concurrency Backlog Authorities
- Labels Transportation facilities as a Category “C” public facility with Level of Service guidelines.
